

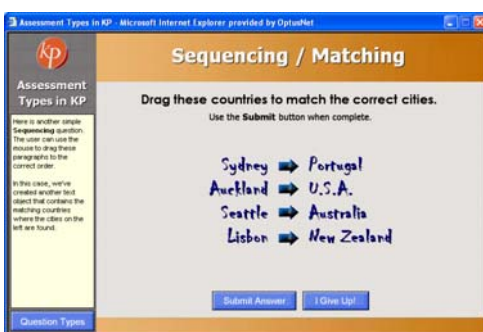
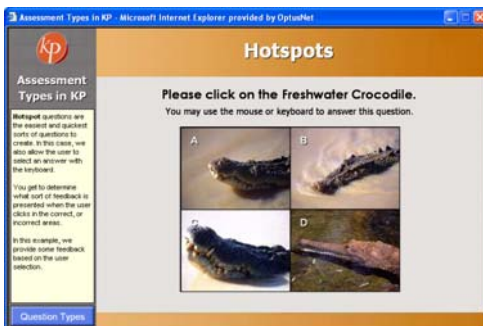

Feature	Benefit
Fully customizable approach	Assessments look the way you want them to look—your colors, your logos, your layout. Or take advantage of our templates.
Use the Power of the KnowledgePresenter Quiz Editor	The Quiz Editor allows you to create quiz data files that can be incorporated into any quiz template. Change the look and behavior of your quiz in seconds—without having to touch the quiz data.
Hotspot Questions	Create hotspot questions to detect user interaction—and respond in any way you like.
Multiple Choice Questions	Turn any text object into a multiple choice object in seconds—set one or more correct answers.
Sequencing / Matching Questions	Ask the user to put a list of options in the correct order—or match the options from one list to another.
Freeform Text Entry / Labeling / Fill in the Blanks Questions	Use the powerful freeform text entry questions to create all sorts of questions that rely on the user to enter an answer or answers. Multiple correct answer, keywords, passwords, and more.
True / False Questions	This powerful question type allows you to let the user select from a series of options, each with on and off states.
Drag and Drop / Matching Questions	Ask the user to drag objects from one part of the screen to another to answer a question.
Forced Text Entry Questions	Great for software simulations—ask the user to answer a question, and only allow them to enter the correct answer.
Sequencing Questions	Ask users to arrange answers in a certain order, or match one list to another, or a series of images.
Drop Down List Questions	Ask users to select the correct answer from a drop down list of options.
Targets Questions	A hotspot / multiple choice quiz hybrid. Let the user select an answer and submit their answer when ready.
Display / Print Results	Optionally display or print at any time the current score, the question number, or a detailed question / answer summary.
Set Time Limits	Set a time limit for individual questions.
Create Objectives	Create Objectives to set scores / weighting for each question, set questions to run over multiple steps.
Record All Results to a Learning Management System	Use the Learning Management System provided or any other SCORM compliant LMS to record user results—including total time, score, and detailed statistics for each question—including question itself, user selection, the correct answer, what they scored—even how long they took to answer the question.
Use Dynamic Results	Alter lesson behaviour based on user results—show more questions for users who get questions wrong, for example.
One or Two Step Submit	Have answers submitted immediately they are selected, or allow users to use a <b>Submit Answer</b> button.
Create Manifest and Package Interchange Files	Create files that will slot in with any SCORM compliant Learning Management System.
Incorporate Other Interaction	Includes assessments with a movie, or other elements such as images, audio, etc.
