

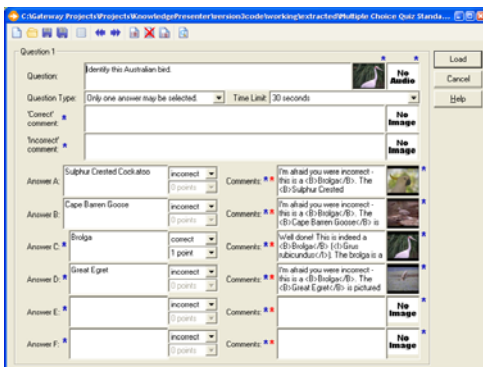
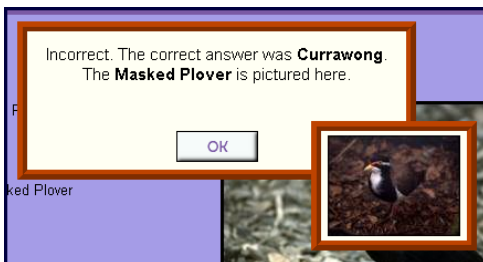

Feature	Benefit
Fully customizable approach	Use any of the Multiple Choice Quiz templates, modify them however you like, or create your own from scratch.
Use the Power of the KnowledgePresenter Quiz Editor	The Quiz Editor allows you to create separate quiz data files that can be incorporated into any quiz template. Change the look and behavior of your quiz in seconds—without having to touch the quiz data.
Use text, images, audio	Questions can contain a combination of text, images, or audio.
Time Limits	Set time limits for questions on an individual or global basis.
Flexible Choices	Include anywhere from 1 to 6 choices per question—and vary this within any individual quiz.
Use single / multiple correct answers	Any question can be defined as having only one, or multiple correct answers.
Score weighting	Set the score for any question individually—any one question or possible answer can be worth 1 to 100 points.
Customizable Pass Score	Set your own pass score to determine whether the user passed or failed the quiz.
Custom Score Feedback	Provide custom feedback based on total user score—for example whether they passed or failed, or based on their score, in 10% increments.
Customizable Feedback	Determine whether to give feedback for any question—as the question is answered, or at the end of the test. Define custom feedback for each answer, or custom 'incorrect' and 'correct' comments for each question—including a picture.
Display/Print Results	Optionally display at any time the current score, the question number, or a detailed summary of every question and answer. Optionally, allow users to print results.
Randomize Questions, or Grouped Questions	Automatically randomize questions so they appear differently every time the test is run.
Use Question Subsets	Automatically have the lesson choose a subset of questions from a larger set—so the test is different every time it is run.
Record All Results to a Learning Management System	Use the Learning Management System provided (Professional Version Only) or any other SCORM compliant LMS to record user results—including total time, score, and detailed statistics for each question—including the question itself, what the user selected, what the correct answer was, what they scored—even how long they took to answer the question.
Skip Questions	Optionally allow users to skip questions and optionally return to them later in the test.
One or Two Step Submit	Have answers submitted immediately they are selected, or allow users to use a Submit Answer button.
Create IMS Manifest and Package Interchange Files	Create files that will slot in with any SCORM compliant Learning Management System.
Incorporate Other Interaction	Includes quizzes with a movie, or other elements such as images, audio, etc.
